Galatians 5:16</p>	<p>The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; Galatians 5:19</p>	<p>Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. <p>The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.
