## Why children should start each day with A Bible verse in their pocket

- 1. Because God's word gives us life and health.
- 2. Because it is one of God's commands to parents. Deut. 6:8
- 3. Because kids learn ONE WORD at a time and a verse a day gives them TIME to learn the big words like faith and love.
- 4. Because a Bible verse in his or her pocket helps a child feel safe in an often scary world.
- 5. Because 5-12 year olds are unlikely to look up a Bible verse on their own... even if they do carry a phone.
- 6. Because it gives the Holy Spirit a chance to influence the child BEFORE his friends do.
- 7. Because the child will remember <u>ALL</u>
  <u>HIS OR HER LIFE</u> starting each day
  with a Bible verse in their pocket.
