Mom/Dad: God's word is the key to life. It unlocks rooms a child wants out of, rooms like fear, anger and loneliness. It also unlocks rooms they want into, rooms like peace, faith and love.  Could you cut out these little cards and help your child find a shower curtain hook?  Then each time he/she has memorized a verse cut out the key on the card and put it on the ring. Once the ring is full save it in a special place.  It is the only way any child will ever be prepared to get behind the wheel of his own life.
