Give your life/home a Bible Makeover

It's a command

Deut. 6:8-9 "You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."



Try these also:

- ☐ A verse in each window... a REMINDER that God's light enters the home through his word.
- ☐ A verse in your car... on the dash and behind the seats. Take God with you wherever you go.
- ☐ In your child's pocket as they leave for school, giving them a constant reminder that God is with them.
- ☐ Just above your doorknobs, so your children know that His word opens the door to Him.
- ☐ Taped to the back of your tv controller and on your computer.
- ☐ Inside your cupboard doors, so it is a surprise each time you open the cupboard.
- ☐ On bulletin boards throughout the city. Sharing God's word with others, a reminder that we are all His children.
- ☐ By the light switches in your church because God's word is a light to our path AND because it helps children view their church as a second home.

- ☐ In as many mirrors as possible... a reminder of God's desire to see His word in you.
- ☐ Add a verse to each child's lunch sack or box BECAUSE God's word is food to our souls.
- ☐ Inside cover of each child's school book because studying God's word is more important than any class in school.
- ☐ Most importantly fill a bowl to place by each child's bed (starting and ending each day with God's word is a memory that will last a lifetime)... then praying together that God move the verse from your heads to your hearts.
- ☐ Put a verse inside a plastic whipped topping lid then play Bible frisbee... Aim at the heart not the head.
