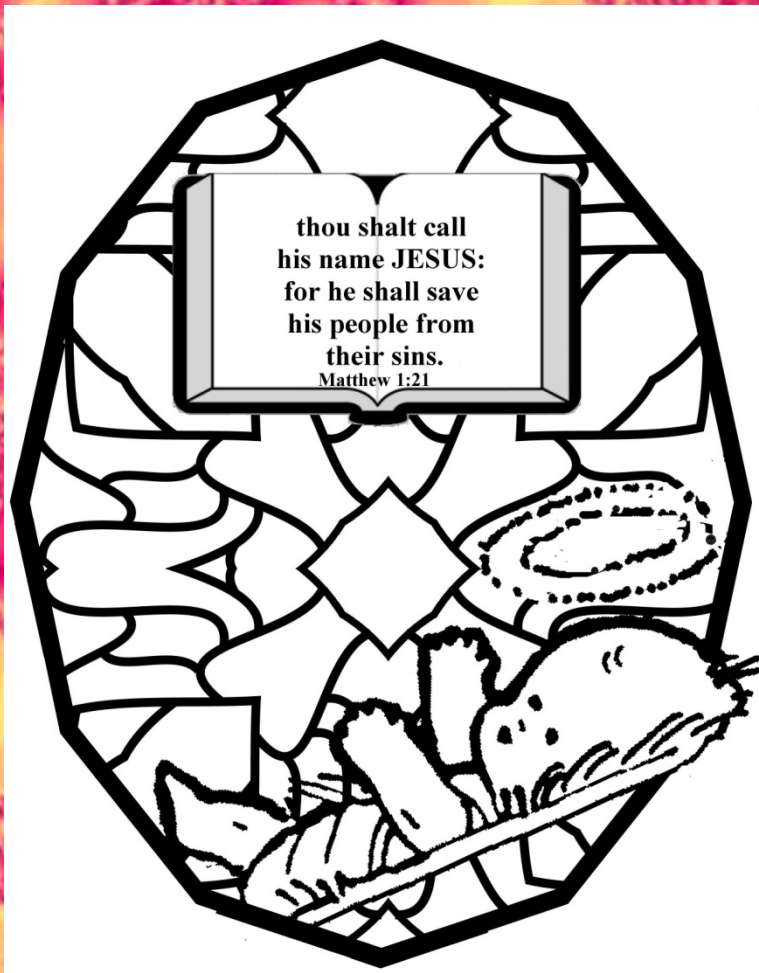

**Our first two coloring pages are full size “Son Catchers” for younger children. They are easier to color than the ornaments and designed to be cut out and taped in a window. When printing Son Catchers use lighter weight paper than for printing ornaments/cards. This lets the light shine through.**



**The remaining coloring projects may be folded in half and used as cards or cut out and glued or stapled together to make a tree ornament...Or both.**

**For best results print the single ornament cards or the full page sets of four ornaments on 22-32 pound paper. 6" x 9" envelopes are the perfect size for our cards and cost only 7-10\$ per 100 at most office supply stores. We have found them to be a good investment for both Sunday school classrooms and or families.**

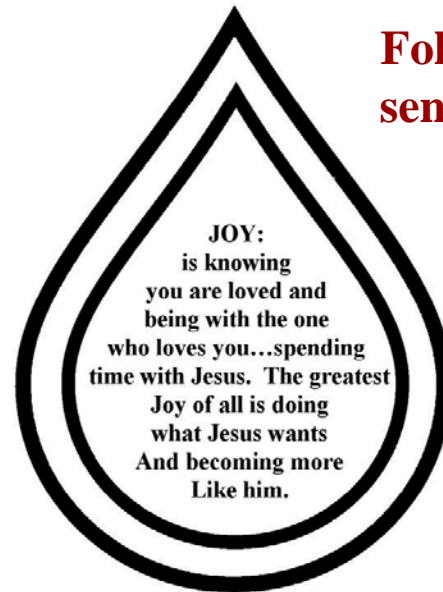
**After coloring the card fold in a short piece of yarn to hang it.**

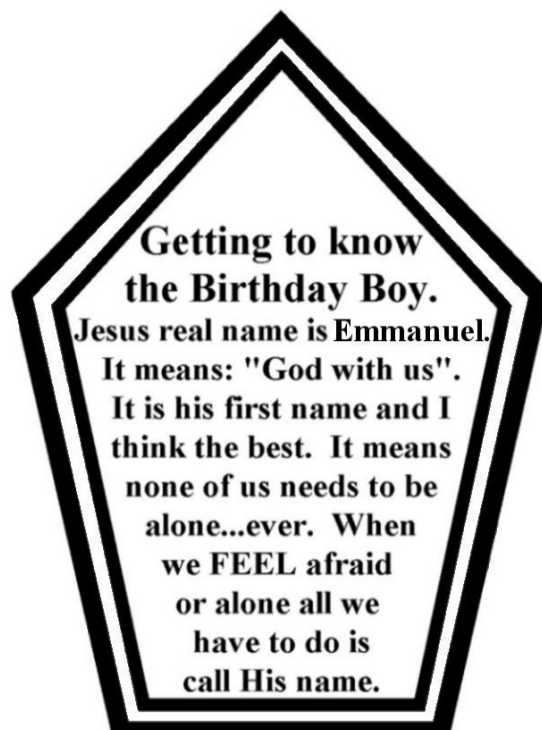
The first name God gives us for his first born child is Emmanuel

Getting to know the Birthday Boy. Jesus real name is Immanuel.. It means "God with us". It is His first name and I think the best. It means none of us needs to be alone...ever. When we FEEL afraid or alone all we have to do is CALL HIS NAME.

Getting to know Jesus Takes a long time And a lot of prayer. You can start with One ornament a day.

Getting to know the Birthday Boy. Who would you choose to be king? Someone selfish, or someone who cares? JESUS always cares. If If you want to be part of HIS kingdom you must trust him; to teach you to pray, to make scripture real, and to help you LOVE OTHERS

Getting to KNOW JESUS One of Jesus names Was HOLY CHILD. He Knows what it is/was like To be helpless almost all the time. It means he also knew/knows that God always puts children at the top of his list... not the bottom.
